

SEXUAL PROBLEMS AND SEXUAL SCRIPTS: OVERVIEW AND FUTURE DIRECTIONS FOR BISEXUAL-IDENTIFIED INDIVIDUALS





WHAT IS THIS PUBLICATION ABOUT?

We conducted a literature review on sexual problems and relationship factors in self-identified bisexual individuals to highlight areas where more research is needed.



WHEN CONSIDERED IN RESEARCH, BISEXUAL INDIVIDUALS ARE OFTEN THOUGHT OF AS A GROUP, BUT THERE MAY BE IMPORTANT DIFFERENCES BETWEEN BISEXUAL INDIVIDUALS IN SAME-GENDER OR MIXED-GENDER RELATIONSHIPS.

FOR EXAMPLE, IT IS POSSIBLE THAT
SHARING SIMILAR BODY TYPES TO ONE'S
PARTNER MAY BE RELATED TO
DIFFERENCES IN THE SEXUAL
EXPERIENCES OF BISEXUAL INDIVIDUALS
IN SAME-GENDER AS COMPARED TO
MIXED-GENDER RELATIONSHIPS.

ALSO, EVER HAVING BEEN SEXUAL WITH A SAME-GENDER PARTNER MAY BROADEN THE SEXUAL REPERTOIRES (SEXUAL SCRIPTS) OF SELF-IDENTIFIED BISEXUAL INDIVIDUALS.



RESEARCH SHOULD INVESTIGATE HOW THE GENDER AND SEXUAL ORIENTATION OF ONE'S CURRENT PARTNER IS ASSOCIATED WITH SEXUALITY VARIABLES.



RESEARCH SHOULD INVESTIGATE HOW SEXUAL RELATIONSHIP OUTCOMES MAY DIFFER DEPENDING ON HOW RESEARCHERS CLASSIFY INDIVIDUALS AS BEING BISEXUAL.

FOR EXAMPLE, IS BISEXUALITY
DEFINED AS SELF-IDENTIFIED SEXUAL
ORIENTATION, SEXUAL HISTORY,
SEXUAL ATTRACTION, SEXUAL
BEHAVIOUR, OR COMBINATIONS OF
THESE ASPECTS?



CLINICIANS SHOULD REFRAIN FROM ASSUMING THE SEXUAL ORIENTATION OF THEIR PATIENTS BASED ON THE GENDER OF THEIR PARTNER.

TO AVOID MAKING
ASSUMPTIONS, CLINICIANS
SHOULD ASK CLIENTS ABOUT
HOW THEY SELF-IDENTIFY IN
TERMS OF THEIR SEXUAL
ORIENTATION.



WHAT ARE THE IMPLICATIONS OF THIS PUBLICATION?

We found gaps in the literature regarding information on sexual problems, sexual scripts, sexual communication, and partner responses. This publication presents important recommendations for future research.
