WHAT IS THE VPAQ?

The Vulvar Pain Assessment Questionnaire (VPAQ) is a measure used to help in the diagnosis of vulvar pain conditions

HOW IS THE VPAQ HELPFUL?

Vulvodynia:

- A form of chronic vulvar pain
- Affects 8% of women
- A complex condition that can be distressing, yet many are uncomfortable seeking help



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In a study of over 200 women with vulvar pain, participants reported:

- Speaking with at least 3 physicians before receiving a diagnosis
- That medical professionals lacked knowledge of vulvar pain symptoms



Patients using the VPAQ reported that:

- They found the VPAQ helpful
- The symptom summaries in the VPAQ accurately described their symptoms
- After completing the VPAQ, they felt more comfortable speaking with their physician about their symptoms



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Physicians using the VPAQ reported that:

- They found the VPAQ helpful
- Symptom summaries based on responses to the VPAQ accurately described patients' symptoms
- The VPAQ led to correct diagnoses
 80% of the time
